**RESOLUTION OF CONDITIONAL APPROVAL**

Conditional Approval of the  
Charter Application of Global Village Academy Charter School

WHEREAS, on March 15, 2013, the Board of Education (“Board”) of the Douglas County School District Re. 1 (“District”) received as charter school application from the founding board of Global Village Academy, a K-8 Charter School, a Colorado nonprofit corporation (“Applicant”), for the establishment of Global Village Academy (“GVA”) as a district charter school; and

WHEREAS, the Board recognizes the demand for and the value of choice school offerings in Douglas County School District RE-1; and

WHEREAS, the Board acknowledges the hard work and efforts on the part of GVA and district staff to meet all of the conditions of the conditional approval previously granted by the Board and desires a healthy balance among expanding choice options, a focus on the best interest of students, and required fiscal soundness and accountability.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board that the charter school application submitted by the Applicant is conditionally granted to begin operations as a district charter school in the fall of 2015 for the 2015-2016 school year and to operate for a term of three (3) years, subject to and pending satisfaction of the following conditions, as well as all other terms and conditions as may be required by law;

1. By September 13, 2014, GVA shall document a minimum of 300 students intending to enroll.
2. By the end of the January 2015 Open Enrollment period, GVA will have 193 full-time equivalent students (FTE) assigned to the various grade levels proposed in the charter school application to be served the first year, as validated by the District’s open enrollment process.
3. GVA shall submit to the Board, on or before February 14, 2015, a location, lease agreement, and an approved traffic plan for an appropriate charter school facility available for use on or before August 1, 2015.
4. GVA shall present a detailed budget for fiscal year 2015-2016, as well as a projected budget for fiscal years 2015-2019 to be approved by the District’s Chief Financial Officer on or before April 1, 2015.
5. GVA will hire a school leader/principal on or before March 1, 2015.

6. GVA and the District will discuss expectations concerning the existing school's Performance Frameworks and Growth by October 1, 2014.
7. GVA District Authorizer non-compliance issues addressed and corrected by May 31, 2014.
8. Unless otherwise stated above or subsequently agreed by the Board, in the event the conditions on Conditions 1 through 7 have not been satisfied by the dates indicated, this conditional approval will be withdrawn and the application will be deemed denied. In no event shall denial for failure of any condition or withdrawal of conditional approval be construed as a revocation of the purported GVA charter or school contract.
9. In the event the above conditions are met by the dates indicated, the GVA board shall sign a charter school contract, acceptable to the Board, on or before April 1, 2015, unless the applicant and the Board or the District's Superintendent agree to extend that date. The contract shall reflect a resolution of the above issues as well as all other required and recommended terms negotiated with District representatives. In the event the Board determines that an acceptable contract has not been achieved by April 1, 2015, or such date as may have been extended as provided herein, the charter school application shall be deemed denied by the Board on the date of such determination. In no event shall the Board action described herein be construed as a revocation of a purported GVA charter or school contract.
