# Staff update (Matt Reynolds)

- DCSD <u>Looking Forward</u>
  - Great information on what we are doing in response to what is happening right now in relation to the strategies, data and other information currently within the district.
- Leadership Connection
  - Deputy Superintendent Hiatt couldn't join but we will reschedule for a future meeting
- Data and UIP Updates
  - In previous DAC meetings there were revisions and recommendations that were submitted. The board approved the plan and it was posted Oct. 15th with the CDE. By following this <u>LINK</u> you can reference the information.
- Equity Advisory Council (EAC) membership
  - The council provides insight, advice, and feedback for equity-focused work occurring across the district. The bylaws are currently being written and will need approval soon.
  - The EAC would like to invite the DAC to have a representative serve on the council. They would like to have someone appointed by our next November DAC meeting. Melody Matthews and Chester Shaw are interested in serving.
  - Vote was facilitated via polling through Google Meet asking who the DAC members would like to nominate for the EAC - Chester will be the DAC representative
    - It was suggested to ask the EAC if Melody Matthews can be the alternative rep for the DAC in Chester's absence .

## Budget Update (ESSER III Funds - SAC Survey) - Colleen Doan

- Colleen provided an overview on Federal Stimulus funding specific for COVID relief in the current fascial year. ESSER III requires stakeholder feedback prior to releasing the funds.
- In previous meetings we reviewed what ESSER I and II funds have been delegated for

- During the presentation this evening we reviewed the survey that has been created for SAC feedback regarding the priorities for distributing the ESSER III.
- The survey will be shared through the below channels
  - o Principle notes and in charter leader notes
    - Face to face meetings with principals providing details about the survey
  - SAC Chairs will receive the survey directly
    - The survey will be open for two months (November and December) for SAC's to complete the survey as one voice representing their SAC.
    - The survey would be sent early November
- Has there been consideration for student, education and other stakeholder voices for feedback?
  - Colleen will need to ask Kate about the additional survey asks
- The budget subcommittee from the DAC gave their feedback as well, which helped generate the survey reviewed during the meeting.
- Chester Shaw Is there a motion to approve the survey?
  - Irene Borisov made a motion to approve the survey with the edits that have been

suggested this evening. Christy Williams seconded and the motion carried.

# CITE and LEAD Update - LEAD Pilot Update - Dr. Deanne Kirby

- LEAD Focus Group is planning 2-3 feedback sessions with the LEAD Pilot Group
  - Timeframe is between November through May
- The finalized rubric will be presented to the DAC in spring of 2022

## **Open Discussion Chester Shaw**

- Siri provided the top themes the forum subcommittee decided on
  - Three themes for the winter forum
    - Parent engagement in schools
      - Screen time
      - The effect of last year and future learning
- Another point of discussion is whether or not the forum should be a one time event or several events spread out across the feeders
  - Potential for small and engaging conversations
- Does the overall DAC feel the one-time event is needed or should we have smaller events spread throughout various areas?
  - Melody Matthews what is the attendance like when we host special events on an occasional basis and in the past what is the attendance with a winter forum which type of event engages the most audience?
  - Matt provided that it depends on the topic and timing. It's more about the content that has brought individuals to the one-time or several district-sponsored events.
- Christy Williams how would we implement the event as a virtual versus an in-person?
  - Siri we don't know at this time and that is something to be decided once we have the one-time or multiple events decision.
- Kelly Pointer personally I think that one night to replace a DAC meeting is easier to attend, content is relevant, and communication about the event would be helpful.
  - Mental Health, Funding, and Special Education these are themes heard throughout the community.
- A poll was generated Would you rather have a single winter forum event or a series of smaller events? The poll reflected a one time event is what we should do

- Stephanie George mentioned considering a virtual room in the main event
  - She is also happy to help with the event
