

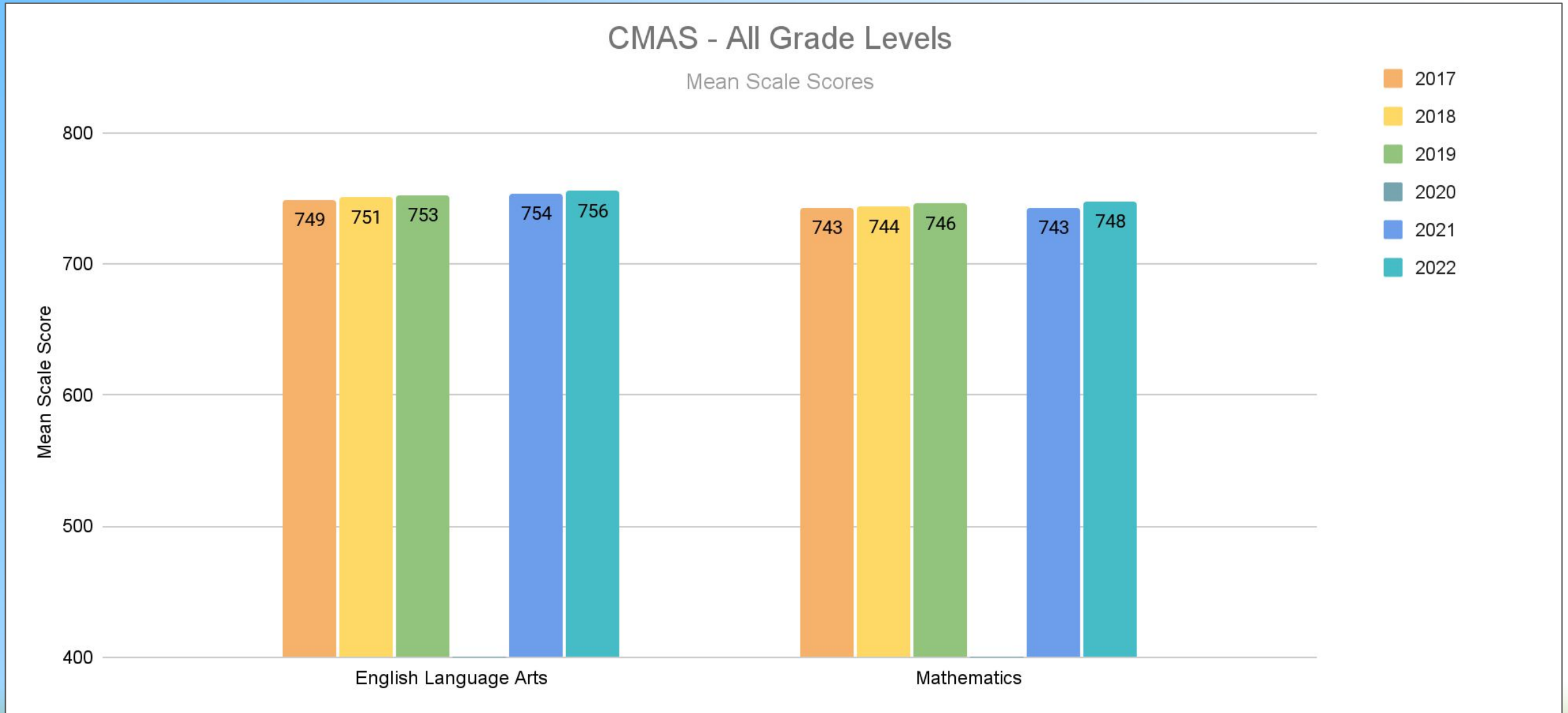

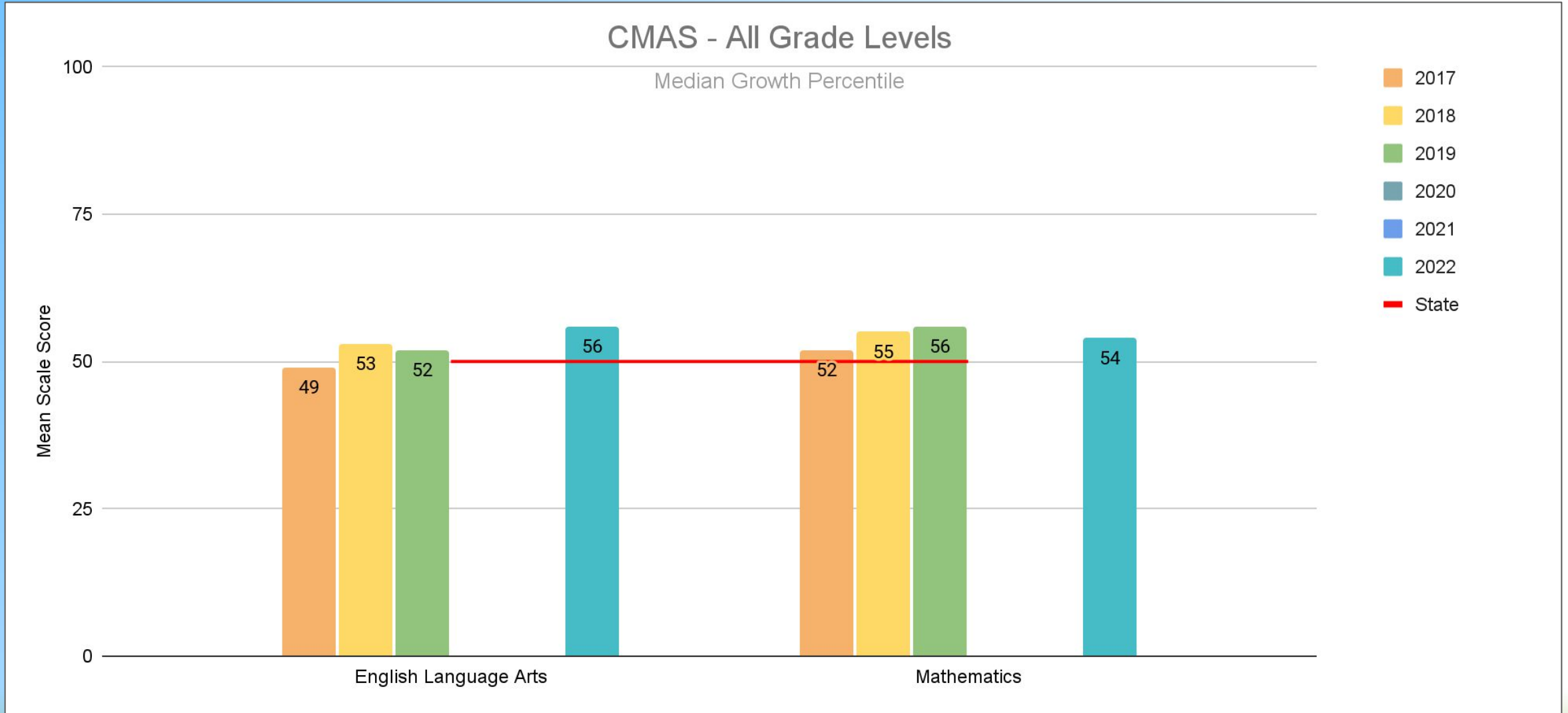

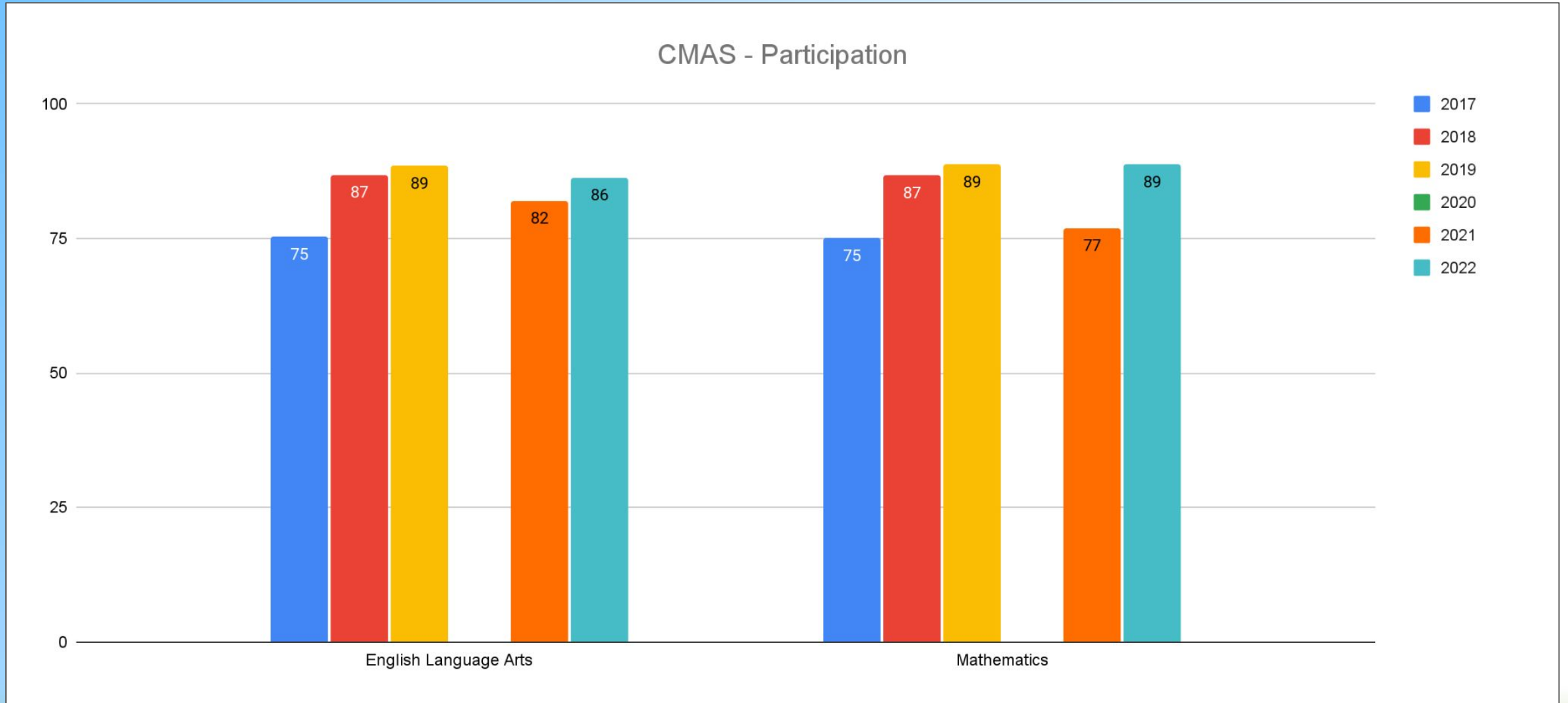
2022 CMAS - Achievement

Literacy Update

- Core Reading Programs Training (August 3rd)
 - Benchmark - 5 trainers, 25 schools, 519 participants
 - Wonders - 7 trainers, 23 schools, 487 participants
- READ Act Teacher Training
 - Per Colorado Department of Education, 1278 DCSD Staff have added the READ Act Designation to their license
 - Over 93% of K-3 teachers have completed the required training (Excludes teachers newly hired to their position as of June 1, 2022)

Next Steps

- i-Ready Beginning of the Year (BOY) Benchmark is being administered
- Colorado Department of Education releases preliminary School and District Performance Frameworks
- Staff presents EOY i-Ready Data Snapshot (September)
