EL 13 Student Accommodation

The Superintendent shall not make decisions regarding student accommodations that <u>fail to</u> balance fiscal responsibility, adequacy of the learning environment, pedagogical soundness, <u>needs</u> of the <u>district overall</u> and program viability.

Accordingly, the Superintendent shall not:

- 1. Recommend and/or make changes to student accommodation, <u>which</u> includes <u>ing</u> school <u>combination elosure</u>, <u>substantive</u> alterations or additions, boundary changes, <u>excess property disposal or sale</u> or grade reconfigurations without first having provided opportunity for input from the staff and <u>relevant Board Committees</u>, <u>such as the Long Range Planning Committee</u>.
- 2. Permit the stakeholders of the any school which may be considered for significant modification of accommodations school in question to be uninformed as to the criteria for such a modification and the ability to provide appropriate feedback on that modification after a school has met the criteria for a school review or grade reconfiguration process.
- 3. Permit any deviation from rigorous adherence to written administrative processes that ensure compliance with legislated requirements for the process of determining a school review, school closure or grade reconfiguration modification of student accommodation, or implementing the decision once made.
- 4. Permit the Board to be without sufficient information to make fully informed decisions regarding regarding substantial modifications of student accommodations. a school review, school closure, or grade reconfiguration.
- **4.5**. Allow use of student accommodations that do not comport with relevant statutes and regulations regarding access for all students.
