# What We've Done



2022 represented a "restart" for Douglas County Community Foundation where we built upon the foundations of the previous two decades and added a new dynamic board and operational structure. Our recent accomplishments include:

- Hired first-ever Executive Director
- Held the most successful fundraising events in DCCF history
- Granted largest amount in any single DCCF granting period
- Raised funds allowing DCCF to grant more in a thirteen-month period than all previous years combined
- Created new, more efficient, and accountable granting process; established quarterly granting cycles
- Created a Community Emergency Relief Fund
- Established a database of nonprofit partners
- Championed DC Gives as part of Colorado Gives Day
- Granted over \$368,000 in 99 grants

# What We've Done



From Dec 2021 through Dec 2022 DCCF granted over \$106,900.00 to Douglas County nonprofits who directly impact Douglas County School District and their students.
