2018-2023 BOND DISTRICT SECURITY FUNDING

- Secure Front End High and Middle Schools
 - Design and construction of secure vestibules at the main entry of schools.
- Vehicles
 - Purchase of new vehicles and required equipment to replace aged fleet.
- Window Film
 - Hardening of specific areas of buildings.

2018 BOND CHARTER SCHOOLS SECURITY FUNDING

- Window Film
 - Completed Hardening of specific areas of buildings.
- Camera Upgrades/VMS
 - Add or replace cameras and video systems to DCSD standards.
- Access Control
 - Add or replace access control to DCSD standards.

2018 BOND DISTRICT SECURITY FUNDING

- School VMS Camera Update
 - Installation of new VMS solution and add/update/expansion of cameras within all DCSD facilities adhering to new standards.
 - VMS completed.
- Access Control System
 - Full replacement of access control system.

BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONER SAFETY GRANT

- Communication Systems
 - Installation of radio infrastructure in high schools and larger charter schools to provide radio coverage for First Responders, Emergency Radio and new school radios purchased under School Safety Disbursement Program Grant.
- Radios
 - Outfit additional larger schools with a second Emergency Radio.
- Exterior Door Alarms
 - Installation of door contacts on exterior doors at high schools and larger charter schools. Monitors status of door open/propped versus closed.

BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONER SAFETY GRANT

- Door Locks
 - Installation of safes that will hold school keys, maps and other pertinent info for First Responders to utilize during an incident.
 - Safes have been received.
- Defend Training
 - Train the trainer and training with local Law Enforcement. Also, covers supplies for the training.
 - 2 training sessions completed. Ongoing trainings to continue.
- Emergency Response Training
 - 3 year multi-agency training with local Law Enforcement.
 - Adolescent Mental Health Training for School Resource Officers and Educators, as well as Active Shooter Training complete. Ongoing trainings to continue.

BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONER SAFETY GRANT

- Ballistic Windows
 - Hardening of specific areas of buildings.
- Emergency Trauma Kits
 - Stop the Bleed kits for all schools.
- Bollards
 - Research underway with local companies.
